Setting

Content

- Gather around the Sacred Space.

- Invite children to share with the class a time when they related to someone in a special way.
- In groups discuss how each of them can choose to be a good influence on others. Do they have a role model?

LESSON 8

Purpose

To help pupils make informed decisions about their lives.

Setting

Music: 'Come Holy Spirit', Alive-O 7 page 288.

Content

- Present the children with some examples of when they might have to make difficult decisions e.g.
 - ~ owning up to the truth,
 - ~ making everyone feel welcome in their group,
 - ~ sharing,
 - ~ how they talk about others.
- In groups, pupils prepare and present role-plays of above scenarios.
- Class discuss outcomes of the scenarios:
 - ~ were the right decisions made?
 - ~ what would have been the consequences if different decisions had been made?
 - ~ what helped them make their decisions?
 - ~ do their decisions matter?

LESSON 9

Purpose

To enable children to face future changes with optimism.

Setting

Music: 'Do Not be Afraid', Alive-O 7 page 295, or
'Been There, Done That', Alive-O 7 page 278.

Content

Discuss:

- What can be good about changes in life?
- What are you looking forward to?
- What worries you about changes in life:
 - ~ meeting new people,
 - ~ taking on new responsibilities,
 - ~ difficulty with examinations.
- In groups, discuss what you are looking forward to next year e.g.
 - ~ new school.
 - ~ new friends,
 - ~ new subjects,
 - ~ more independence etc.
- What are your fears?
- How to deal with them.
- Emphasise the importance of Confirmation and the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Activity

- In groups design a poster for a wall display titled: 'Looking Forward', (possible topics):
 - ~ new friends,
 - ~ independence,
 - ~ Holy Spirit help me,
 - ~ choices.


