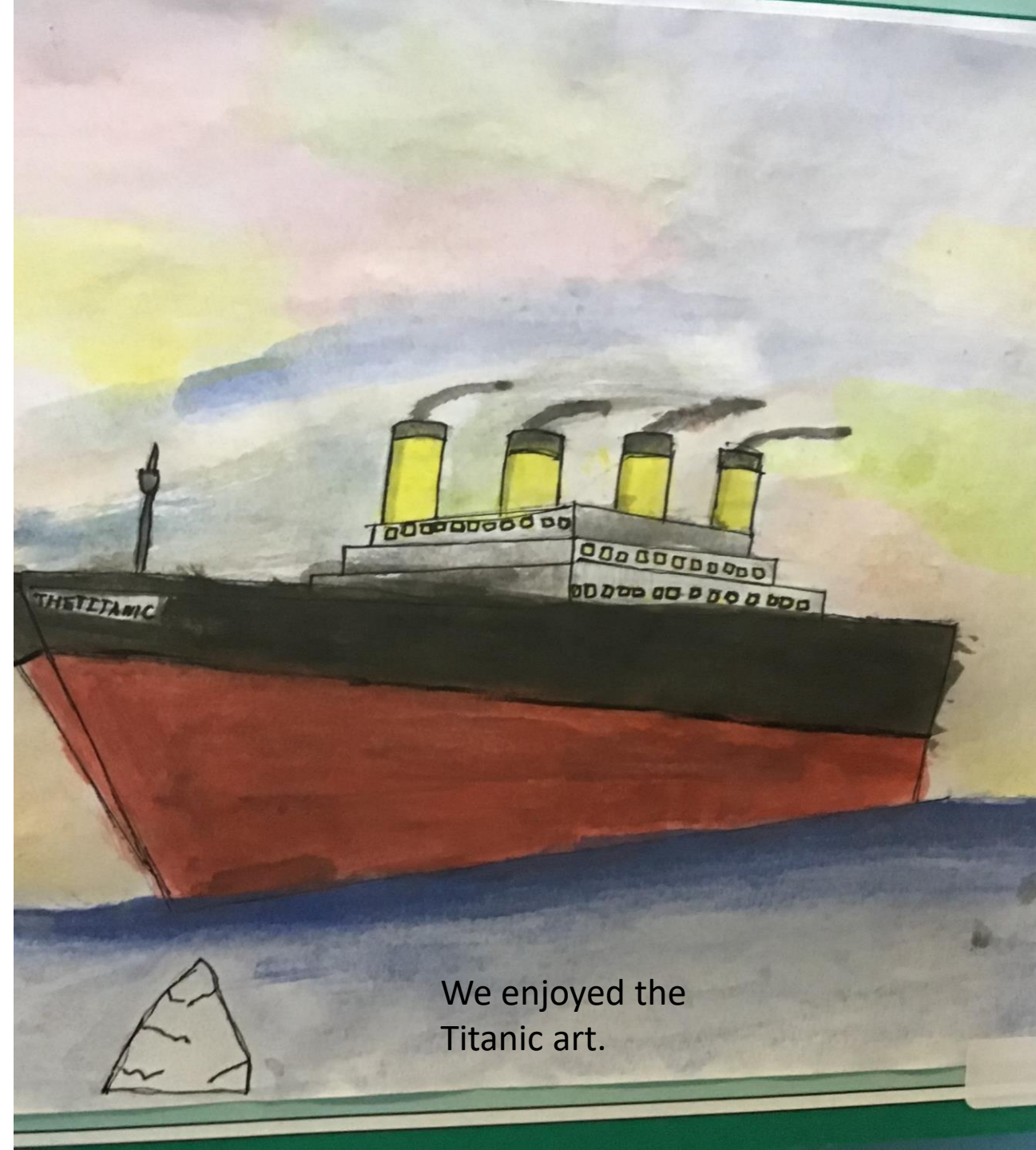

- It sank on its maiden voyage



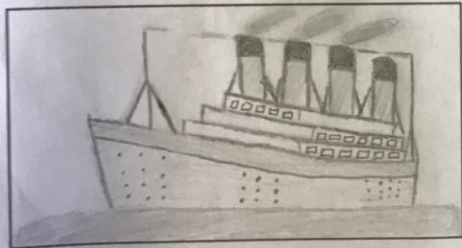

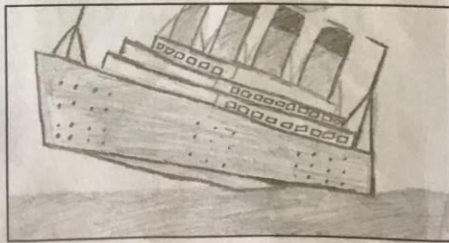
The unsinkable ship

The Titanic was built in Belfast, Northern Ireland by Harland and Wolff for transatlantic passage between Southampton, England and New York. It took three years to build between 1909-1912.



On April the 10th the Titanic set sail on its first maiden voyage. 2240 people were on board and they were very confident that they would make it to New York in five days.

Four days later the Titanic was sailing smoothly when the captain heard three rings from the crew's nest which meant iceberg right ahead. The side of the ship was hit and everybody began to panic. People start to pull and push trying to get to the bow.



Water filled up more than four compartments and that meant that the ship would only stay afloat for a few hours. The life boats start to be

- Others wouldn't allow her

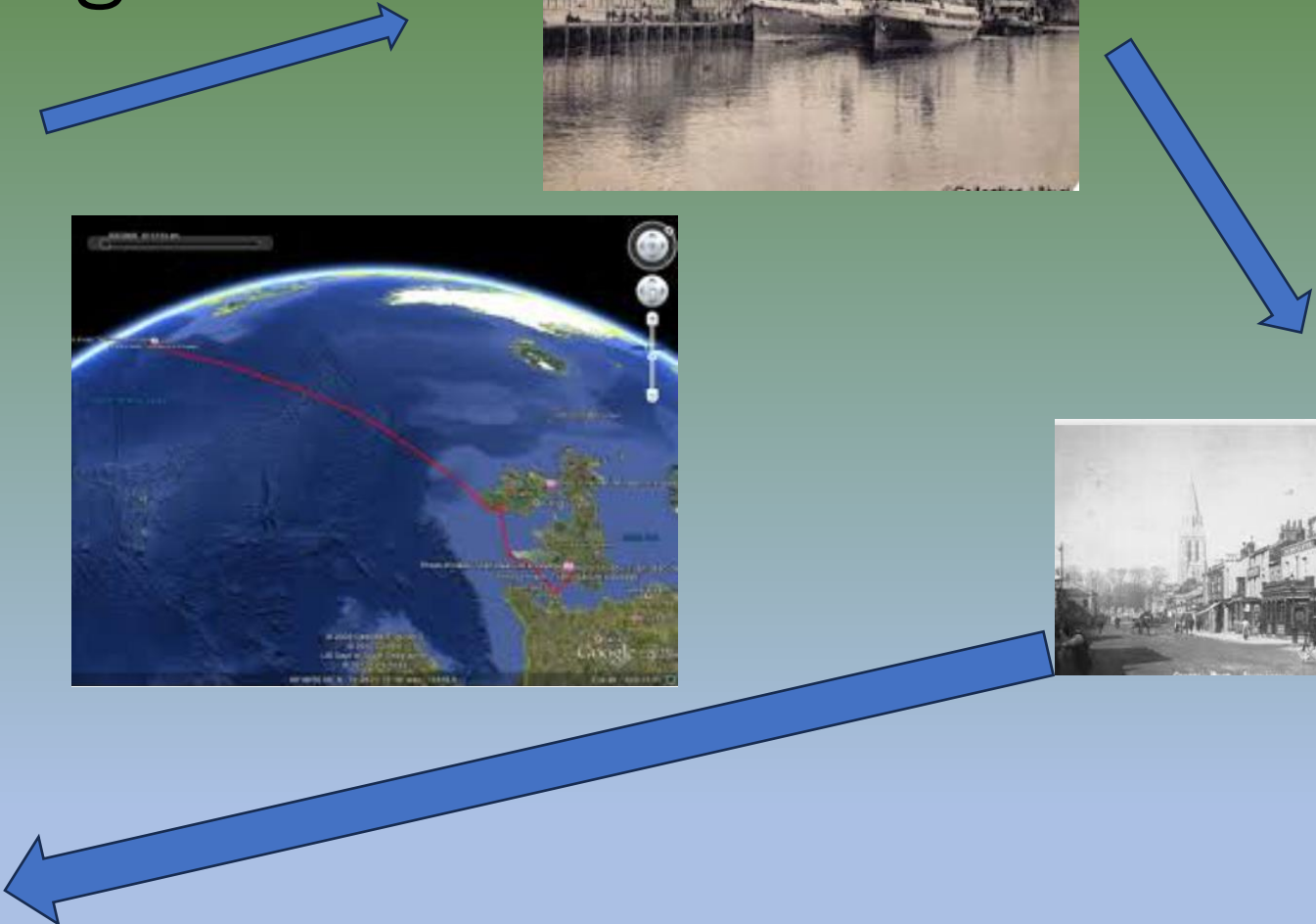


Captain Edward Smith

- Smith had served in the Navy
- He was the captain of the Titanic
- He gave the order to go full speed ahead
- This was after the ship received warnings of ice-bergs
- Captain Smith went down with the Titanic



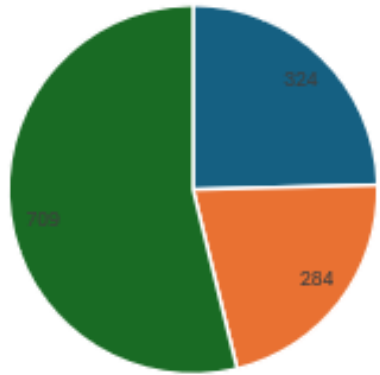

- 912 passengers boarded at Southampton.
- 10 passengers boarded at Belfast.
- 466 were Females.
- 705 passengers survived on the Titanic.
- 9 passengers were called Smith.
- 6 passengers were older than 60.
- 34 passengers' first names were George.
- Bruce Ismay's secretary was called William Henry Harrison.
